

Would you like to interview a celebrity one day? If so, then try this challenge!






Who would you like to interview? It could be a sports celebrity, a pop star or even a superhero – anyone you like!



Now think of five questions you would love to ask them. The idea is to end up with five interesting facts, plus an exclusive news story.









This is where the grown-ups get involved. They will play the part of the celebrity and you will be interviewing them. Make notes as they reveal their facts and pay attention - they might have a big announcement to make! This is called an exclusive!


You will need to write a headline and an introduction (that's the bit that explains the headline). For example:

Headline Five facts about Taylor Swift

Introduction Think you know everything about Taylor? Think again!

Find a picture from a magazine to make your interview look exciting. Your chosen celebrity will be the main image, but you could find smaller pictures to add in as well. So, if they say that they love dogs, you could find a picture of a dog to go with that quote.





















Learn how to put together some picture quizzes for your reader to do.



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TRUE OR FALSE QUIZ



Think of a topic for your True or False quiz. Make sure it's something that you really like or know a lot about. You could even make it about yourself!



Write instructions for your reader about what they need to do.



Write a list of facts.
Some should be true, and others should be false. For example, 'Rita Ora is a pop star' (True!). 'Pete Adore Ya is a movie star' (False!).



Add the answers to the bottom of the page, then finish off by adding a relevant drawing or picture cut out from a magazine.

Stick the three face parts onto your page and write instructions for your reader. Your Face Mash-Up quiz is ready!




Write the answers to the quiz at the bottom of the page. Make them small, or even write them upside down. Your reader will check the answers when they have tried the quiz.

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
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REDITOR ECHALLENGE Storytelling


















Choose a name for your magazine. Will it be called *Girl Talk*, *MEGA* or something different? Think about who your main cover star will be. This will be the biggest picture on the page. You will also need to have a *cover line* to go with the image. This is a headline that explains why the star is in the magazine. For example:

'We're going bananas for Minions!' or 'Could you join The X Factor?'



Choose other pictures to go on your cover. They could be celebrities, animals, cartoon characters – whatever you want!



Decide which other words you will have on your cover. You could use speech bubbles or cover lines.

Keep them short and get straight to the point.

How much will your magazine cost?

What gift will you have on the cover?



Use pictures from your image pack or find photos to cut out from a magazine to add to your cover. Make it exciting and fun so that people will want to pick it up!



Only put things on your cover that your readers will want to see and read about.
