# Get Blackpool Reading 31 day reading challenge



## Are you up to our 31 day reading challenge?

Complete a new literacy-themed activity every day. Just 10 minutes of reading a day is enough time to improve your mood and your learning.

- Read a sentence aloud to the tune of your favourite song
- Read a page while balancing another book on your head
- Read a paragraph while standing on one leg like a flamingo
- Download and complete the Get Blackpool Reading Big Book Giveaway activity sheet at [getblackpoolreading.org.uk](http://getblackpoolreading.org.uk)
- Whisper read a whole page
- Recreate your favourite book cover and take a photo
- Read a book to a pet or a teddy
- Do three star jumps after reading a page of your book
- Imagine your favourite book character is visiting Blackpool seafront. Can you draw the scene?
- Read a chapter in a new voice (try a robot or a pirate)
- Read a Collins Big Cat ebook for free
- Design a three box comic strip to show what happens in your favourite book
- Make time for Blackpool Libraries Facebook live storytelling session
- Take a reading selfie
- Download the Libby app to borrow e-books from your local library
- Change the first word of every sentence you read to your name
- Download the make-your-own Bear Hunt resource from [getblackpoolreading.org.uk](http://getblackpoolreading.org.uk)
- Read for 10 minutes wearing your favourite clothes or in fancy dress
- Check out Puffin Storytime on YouTube
- Read a story to a friend or family member over the phone or on a video call
- Act out a scene from your favourite book using your toys
- Design a Blackpool illumination based around the book you're reading
- Listen to a free audiobook from Audible
- Think of two questions you would ask the author of a book
- Make a list of your top three genres of book (adventure, fantasy, comedy...)
- Write an extra chapter to a book you just finished
- Read a chapter by torchlight
- Write a limerick about your favourite book character
- Describe the main character from the book you're reading in just three words
- Write a book review about a book you've finished recently
