




International Women's Day Book List

Changing life stories


To celebrate International Women's Day, we have created a book list of our Behind the Cover titles.

"Girl, woman, other' made me think about the different lives of the women around me and how we all have our own story to tell. The book became a good friend to me in the first national lockdown."




Burnt Sugar Author: Avni Doshi Publisher: Penguin Books
