1. Make up your own song


Take a well-known song and make up your own version.

2. Silly soup

Find a large container at home to put objects in and make *Silly SOUP*, whilst singing this rhyme (to the tune of *Pop Goes the Weasel*).

After each verse, put in an object from around the house that starts with the same sound, e.g. *pencil, pot, pyjamas, pen.* Then give the silly soup a stir with a wooden spoon!

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
