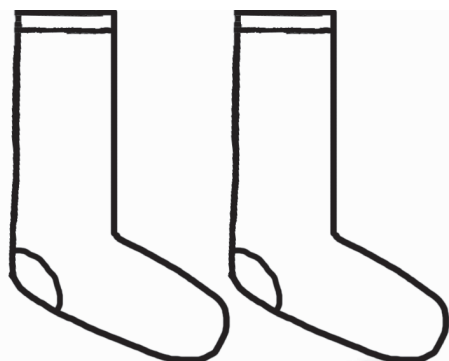
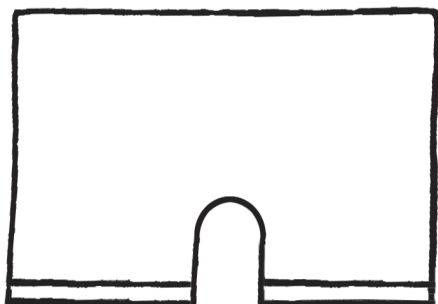
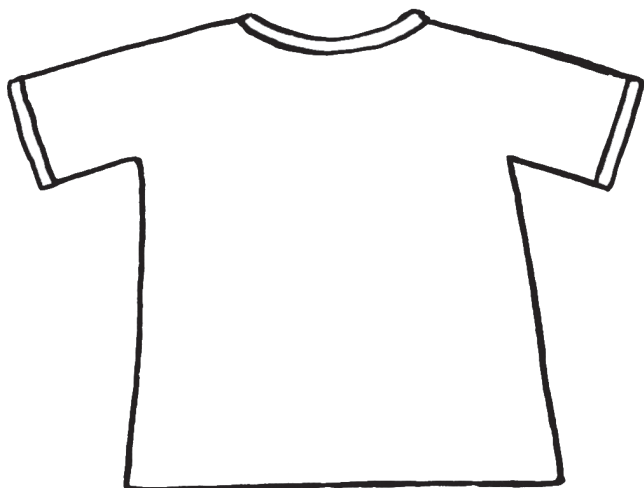
Shirt colour is such an important part of a club's identity that fans often use it as a nickname for the team. Design your own club kit and give them a nickname.

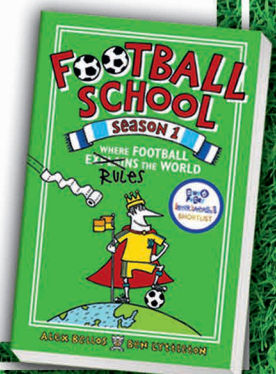

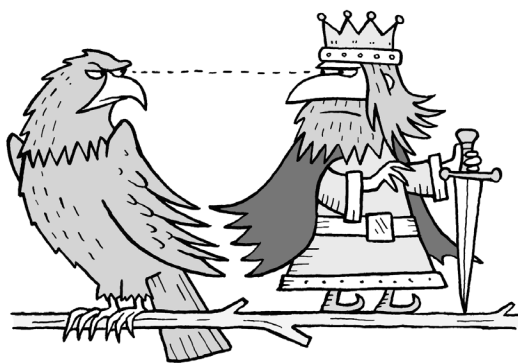

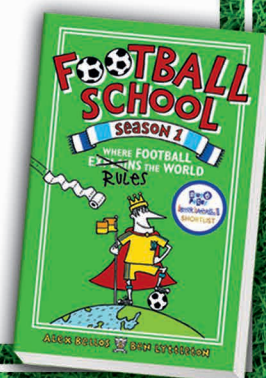
Lots of teams have animal mascots, which fans believe symbolize their team and bring them good luck. Use the space below to design your own team mascot and give it a name.

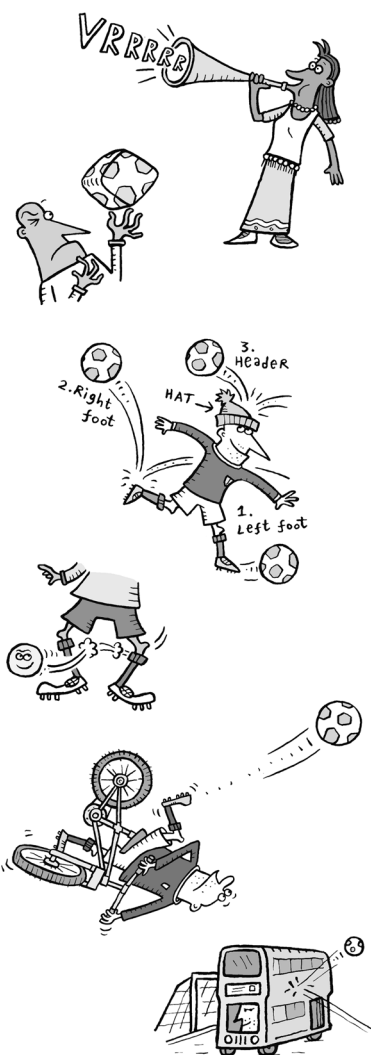

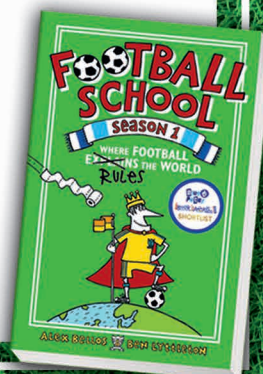

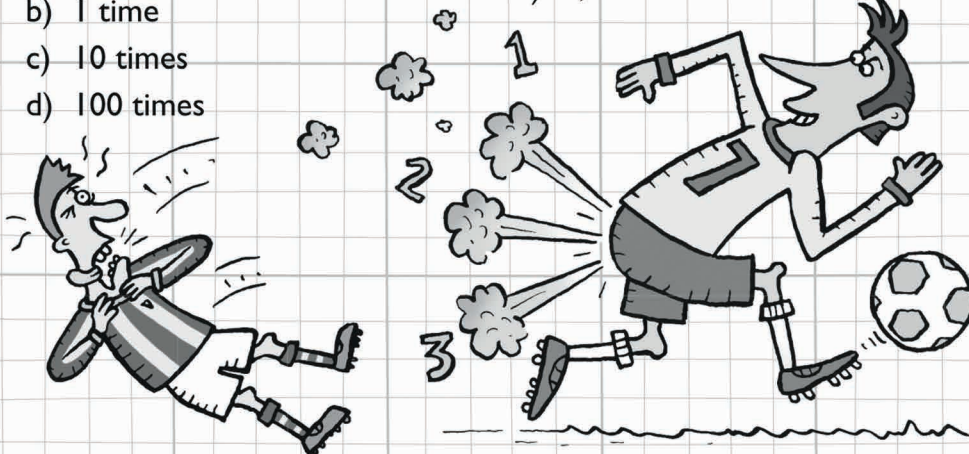
