## Some children have a childhood that is hard to imagine

Imagine struggling to read and dreading that sooner or later everyone will find out.

**Imagine** your school is closed and your mum or dad can't help you learn at home.

**Imagine** not having a single book of your own.

Children from the poorest backgrounds shouldn't have their potential cut short before their lives have even really begun. Yet, on average, they will start school with vocabularies that are 19 months behind their peers. In this climate they are more vulnerable than ever before. They'll be:

- Five times more likely to fail to meet the expected standards in English at age 11
- Four times more likely to struggle to read as adults
- Three times more likely to have mental health problems as adults
- Twice as likely to be unemployed at age 34

School closures will only widen the attainment gap suffered by disadvantaged students, who are already twice as likely to leave school without good GCSEs in English and maths than their better off classmates. These children often don't have the technology they need to effectively learn from home and their parents frequently lack the skills, confidence and motivation to support their learning outside of a school environment.

We need your help now to support these children through this unprecedented situation and to ensure we are able to continue supporting them when this crisis is over.

#### **During school closures:**
