

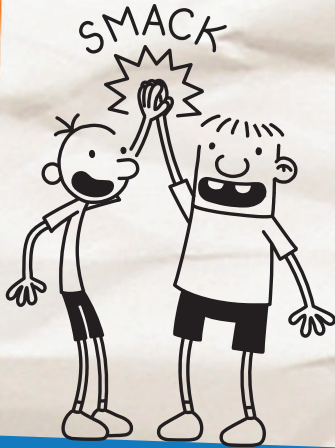

Before Jeff Kinney came up with the idea for *Diary of a Wimpy Kid*, he ran a comic strip called *Igdoof* in his university newspaper.

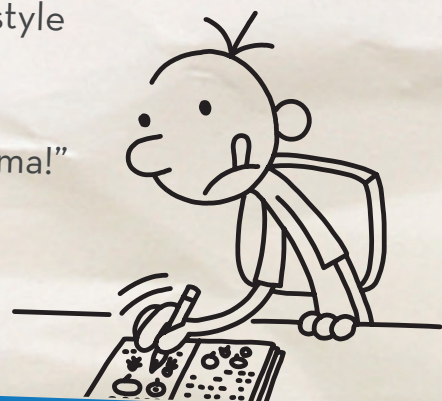

- Characters and scenes drawn in a cartoon style
- Something funny that happens to your main character on the first day back at school
- Your main character shouting "Zoo-Wee Mama!" at the end
