


Story dice

Use the dice when reading together with a grownup or friend to help you talk about highlights from the story.

How to use the dice

1. Download and print off this resource. Then ask a grownup to help you carefully cut out both of the dice – make sure you don't cut off the tabs by mistake!
2. Make folds on the lines between each square and then form a cube by carefully tucking in each of the tabs
3. Pick a book to read with someone else for at least 10 minutes
4. After you've finished reading, roll the dice and have a chat about your answers to the questions that the dice has landed on
5. Roll your dice again and again to help bring your story to life!

Bonus activity

You can use these dice to help plan your own story! Every author has to think about 'Who?, What?, Where?, When?, Why?' and How?' so write these words down to help you plan! You can use the questions on the dice for extra details.
